Adding Videos To Your Wiki

1. Select manage wiki on the left side of your wiki page or select edit.
2. Under content, select “Files” or in edit mode, select “File.”
3. Select “Upload Files” to upload several files at one time.
4. Return to your wiki pages and select “File.” Choose file type and begin adding files to your page.
5. Save your work
